PBS SUPERSTARS

Congratulations to these students, our final Superstars for the year! Rowan, Tara, Tristan, Rhiannon, Chloe and Damian are proud SuperStar trophy earners.



It has been a busy year for PBS, and we have many things to celebrate. In Term 2, we launched our Weekly PBs and Passports. This reward system recognises the efforts of students who are consistently respectful, responsible, cooperative and resilient in all aspects of school life. Students earn Weekly PBs by having a complete week of positive behaviour. Eight Weekly PBs earn a Ticket to our end of term celebrations. 125 students earned their Gold Ticket which means they've shown excellent PBS Values for at least 24 (out of 30) weeks. 93% of students earned at least one Ticket what a great result for our students' learning and positive experience of school.

We also trialled a timetable during Recess and Lunch with classes take turns using the climbing equipment and grassed areas. There has been a 50% drop in the number of negative incidents in the playground and students are observed happily chatting, playing hand ball, skipping and climbing on the equipment. We will continue to support our students in learning to cooperatively play ball games on the field; and our School Welfare Officer, Merryn, is often out in the playground at break times, supporting students' positive social play.

I'd like to thank the school community for supporting PBS and its activities. We have been able to purchase a wonderful range of prizes and fund celebration activities thanks, in part, to your 'gold coin' donation on our PBS Celebration days. We'd also like to that Raine & Horne, Nowra, for their generous donation of \$200 towards PBS.
